Temporary Monthly Gratitude Bonus Update

Shaloni recently shared some great news about an increase in the Temporary Monthly Gratitude Bonus. Please see her note below:

Dear Lexington staff members,

We have received questions regarding the Temporary Monthly Gratitude Bonus payouts so we wanted to provide updated information that should help clarify.

Please understand that these bonuses have many different rules than any bonus we have ever paid previously. We have experienced processing issues as there are so many checks being processed right now. Normal payroll checks (and ADP checks in Schoharie) can only be processed on certain days. March 12 was when the last payroll ended. Our payroll team first processed that to issue paychecks on March 18. There simply wasn't enough time to calculate the TMGB and include it in the March 22 TMGB check date. We are aware that this caused some confusion with our employees. Hopefully the information included below will help answer any questions.

The first TMGB check was distributed on 2/25/22 and included the bonus for DSP hours worked between 1/30/22-2/12/22. The calculations in this check were at the originally announced rate of 15% and 25% bonus as noted below.

Hours receiving 15% Bonus on base wages

Monday - Thursday 7am - 11pm

Friday 7am – 3pm

Hours receiving 25% Bonus on base wages

Monday – Thursday 11pm – 7am Friday 3pm – Monday 7am

The second TMGB check was distributed on 3/22/22 and included the bonus for hours worked between 2/13/22 - 2/26/22. The calculations in this check were paid at the increased amounts of 25% and 45% as indicated below.

Hours receiving 25% Bonus on base wages

Monday - Thursday 7am - 11pm

Friday 7am – 3pm

Hours receiving 45% Bonus on base wages

Monday – Thursday 11pm – 7am Friday 3pm – Monday 7am

The dates below indicate future check dates and show the dates that will be included in each check. They will all be at the new increased rates.

Is the Apprenticeship Program Right for You?

Have you considered going to college?
Wondering how to pay for it?
Asking how you further your education while still working? We have the program for you!

Program overview: this is a New York State approved apprenticeship program for direct support professionals. This two (2) year program combines job related courses at FMCC along with onthe-job (OJT) training. Apprentices will enroll in related courses at FMCC *at no cost. Tuition is fully funded* by a grant available through the NYS Department of Labor and Lexington. Additional grant funding may be available to those who meet income requirements to cover the cost of books, related travel, and child care.

Upon successful completion of all program coursework and OJT, apprentices will earn:

- A certificate in individual studies with the title of direct support professional through the SUNY system.
- A total of 35 college credits to be applied towards an associate's or bachelor's degree.
- An apprenticeship credential as a skilled worker within the DSP trade.

Advocate For Raises for Lexington!

Your action is needed to support a cost of living #raise (#COLA) for you and Lexington.

Budget negotiations are underway, and we need you to rise your voice! The Assembly's proposed budget includes an 11% cost of



living increase (#COLA) for our field. Now is the time to call on your legilsators to include the full COLA in the final budget!

The Link below will allow you to send a message to state leaders to let them know you support the 11% COLA in 2 minutes. When you click on the link, you will be asked to enter your name and address/email/phone number in a form. You will then see two form letters in which all you have to do is enter your full name on the first line of each. Then click submit! That's it!
